
At 25/15z, HURRICANE NARDA was centered near 16.1N 116.6W (about 556NM SW OF THE SOUTHERN TIP OF BAJA CALIFORNIA), MOVING WNW'WARD AT 13KTS, with maximum winds 80-100 kts. Gale Radius is 080nm NW'rn Quadrant, 120nm NE'rn Quadrant, 130nm SE'rn Quadrant, 100nm SW'rn Quadrant.

Tropical East Pacific: On the 27th, a weak area of low pressure could form near 11N/146W. This low is expected to remain weak as it tracks generally W'ward. No tropical development is expected.

Aside from the above, no other areas of tropical development are anticipated through the next 1-3 days.

Weather Routing's Extended Forecast: At this time, no areas of tropical development are expected through the next 4-7 days.

WRI will continue to monitor the East and Central Pacific for tropical activity and keep you well advised.
